## Estructuras básicas

Expresión	Cómo se usa
Should / Shouldn't	Should + verbo normal
Why don't you...?	Why don't you + verbo
If I were you...	If I were you, I would + verbo
How about...?	How about + verbo-ing
You might want to	Might want to + verbo
You'd better	You'd better + verbo
Have you thought about...?	Thought about + verbo-ing
I recommend...	I recommend + verbo-ing

## Expresiones y ejemplos

Expresión	Significado	Ejemplo
To take the bull by the horns	Tomar el toro por los cuernos	You need to take the bull by the horns and ask your boss for a raise.
To go with the flow	Ir con la corriente	Don't stress about the changes at work, just go with the flow.
To play it by ear	Improvisar	We don't need to plan our entire road trip. Let's play it by ear.
To let sleeping dogs lie	Dejar las cosas como están	I know you want to ask about his ex, but I'd let sleeping dogs lie.
To be a shoulder to cry on	Ser un hombro en el que llorar	If you need someone to talk to, I'm here to be a shoulder to cry on.
To look before you leap	Pensar antes de actuar	Always look before you leap.
To cross that bridge when you come to it	Resolverlo cuando llegue el momento	We'll cross that bridge when we come to it.
To take one step at a time	Ir paso a paso	Take one step at a time.
To keep one's chin up	Mantenerse positivo	Keep your chin up. Something better will come along.
To see the light at the end of the tunnel	Ver la luz al final del túnel	I can see the light at the end of the tunnel.
